



Clear Creek Combined Sewer Capacity Relief Project

Project Overview:

The City of Atlanta Department of Watershed Management (DWM), in conjunction with Atlanta Beltline, Inc (ABI), will construct a stormwater detention pond in the Historic Fourth Ward Park which will serve as a functional amenity for the surrounding community. The City is undertaking the Clear Creek Combined Sewer Capacity Relief Project as part of a Federal Consent Decree.

The stormwater pond will be integrated into the initial phase of the Historic Fourth Ward Park (H4WP). In September 2007, Atlanta City Council approved the transfer of \$30 million from DWM to ABI to allow it to design, manage and construct this phase of the project on behalf of the City of Atlanta. ABI will design and fund future phases of the H4WP project.

Project Description:

The project includes construction of a nine-million-gallon stormwater detention pond that will capture stormwater runoff from an approximately 800-acre drainage area upstream of the North Avenue location. Once completed, the detention pond will provide peak flow attenuation to the Highland Combined Sewer Trunk and capacity relief to the overall Clear Creek Combined Sewer Basin.

The original design of the project called for the construction of an underground conveyance tunnel at an estimated price tag of \$40 million. However, the creation of the stormwater pond creates a functional, creative and sustainable feature for the neighborhood and a cost savings for DWM.

Project Location:

The Clear Creek Combined Sewer Capacity Relief Project will be located one block south of City Hall East and bordered by North Avenue on the north, Rankin Street on the south, North Angier Avenue on the east and Glen Iris Drive on the west.
