Riparian Buffer Authorized Encroachment - Public Notice Form

Pursuant to Atlanta City Code § 74-310, public notice and public comment are required as a condition for the grant of an authorized encroachment. Complete the following sections to certify completion of public notice.

You must return this form to the Technical Panel notifying the public for your application to receive further consideration.

Part 1: Mail Notice to Adjoining Property Owners. Send notice to all owners of real property adjoining the stream or wetland for a distance of <u>200 feet upstream</u> and <u>500 feet downstream</u> as measured from the property line contiguous to the stream or wetland. You may wish to use the City's GIS tools to determine the appropriate landowners to notify <u>https://gis.atlantaga.gov/</u>. When there are special circumstances that, in the sole discretion of the Technical Panel, render application of the above rule problematic (e.g. a stream is piped or begins on the property), notify *at least* all property owners of adjoining lots, including the landowners on the opposite side of the stream or wetland. List the addresses that received notice below (you may attach additional pages).

Attach the following documents as proof of compliance:

□ Copies of notification form sent to upstream and downstream property owners; and

 \Box A map showing the properties notified by shading or cross-hatching the relevant parcels or lots.

Part 2: Mail Notice to NPU Chairperson. Notify the Chairperson of the NPU (Neighborhood Planning Unit) for the subject property. Part 3: State of Georgia 25-foot Riparian Buffer. If work is proposed within twenty-five feet (25') of the stream as measured in accordance with § 74-303, a stream buffer variance from the State of Georgia Department of Natural Resources Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is mandatory. Include the application for, or the approved variance in the notice sent pursuant to Parts 1 and 2.

Part 4: Certification. I hereby certify that I have completed the public notification requirements set out in § 74-310 of the Atlanta City Code. I have fulfilled the requirements of Parts 1, 2, and 3 of this form and have provided the required documentation as an attachment hereto. I further certify that all information provided in this form and in the supporting documentation attached hereto is true and correct. I acknowledge that the omission or misrepresentation of a material fact may require an additional public notice period and may constitute grounds for denial of my application.
